<b>Be represented in our school photo collage, week beg. 8<sup>th</sup> May.</b>		
Name three things that you would put in to a time capsule, to be buried at school. (Best ideas from a number of entries will be placed in the capsule.)		
<b>Learn the words to the new Great Linford Song, starts 21<sup>st</sup> May.</b>		
Design our school's 30 <sup>th</sup> celebration logo, winners to be displayed on our school website.		
<b>Become a 'Pavement Artist', week beg. 21<sup>st</sup> May.</b>		
Make up a new playground game and share it with your class.
